....we had a marvelous evening together this past Saturday night. So many people worked very hard and very well under adverse conditions to provide a wonderful meal and setting for our fellowship. Wednesday afternoon, we participated in the dedication of our grand Habitat for Humanity Home at 2405 Par Drive. Kesha Brooks and her five children have a wonderful new home because of this church. This home is the first two story Habitat House in the CSRA. Two of Mrs. Brooks' children have special needs and the house was designed to accommodate their needs. I can only try to imagine the profound effect their new home will have on the Brooks family and I thank you very deeply for that. We have surely done a wonderful thing for this family, for God and for good together. You have been a great blessing, indeed.

Early Service Choir

This choir helps to lead the music at the 8:30 a.m. worship service. We meet year round on Sunday mornings at 8:10 a.m. to rehearse the liturgy, hymns, and psalm.

Service Choir

This choir leads the music for the 11:00 a.m. worship service. We meet weekly (September-May) on Wednesday evenings at 6:45 p.m. and on Sunday mornings at 10:30 a.m. Some musical training or experience is a plus but not required to be a part of this choir.

Resurrection Ringers

Youth Choir and Hand bells
